





ATS 2020+1 New Zealand hub at Eden Park, 11 May – 12 May 2021

The Australasian Tunnelling Conference (ATS2020+1) is the premier tunnelling industry conference in Australasia. The organising committee are celebrating 50 years of tunnelling conferences in the region with a theme of innovation to continue the knowledge sharing and peer-to-peer networking tradition that only happens at conferences. The NZTS are pleased to be able to support a long tradition of regional tunnelling conferences and look forward to seeing you at Eden Park on the 11th and 12th of May.

The conference previously scheduled for November 2020 has been moved to 2021. Due to ongoing travel restrictions, the NZTS is organising a presentation hub at Auckland's Eden Park. The New Zealand hub event will include virtual participation with the Australian conference, in-person presentations from New Zealand presenters, and networking events amongst New Zealand participants.

Registration is \$750 and includes:

- Live content from all three conference streams from Australia with state-of-the-art audio-visual and stable virtual connections in Eden Park conference facilities;
- Live, in-person presentations by New Zealand presenters that will also be broadcast to Australia from Eden Park;
- Links to the videos of the content from day 3 to be provided after the conference;
- Downloadable link of conference technical proceedings to be provided after the conference;
- Catering and the opportunity to socialise with your New Zealand peers;
- New Zealand-specific content at the start of each day; and
- 16 hours of CPD.

A conference dinner will be held at Eden Park on Wednesday, 12 May with tickets purchased separately from the conference. Tickets are \$150 (no need to attend the conference hub if you cannot make it). This will be an entertaining evening and will include a lifetime achievement award for an outstanding contribution to New Zealand tunnelling.
